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Author Correction: Genetically modified pigs with CD163 point mutation are resistant to HP-PRRSV infection

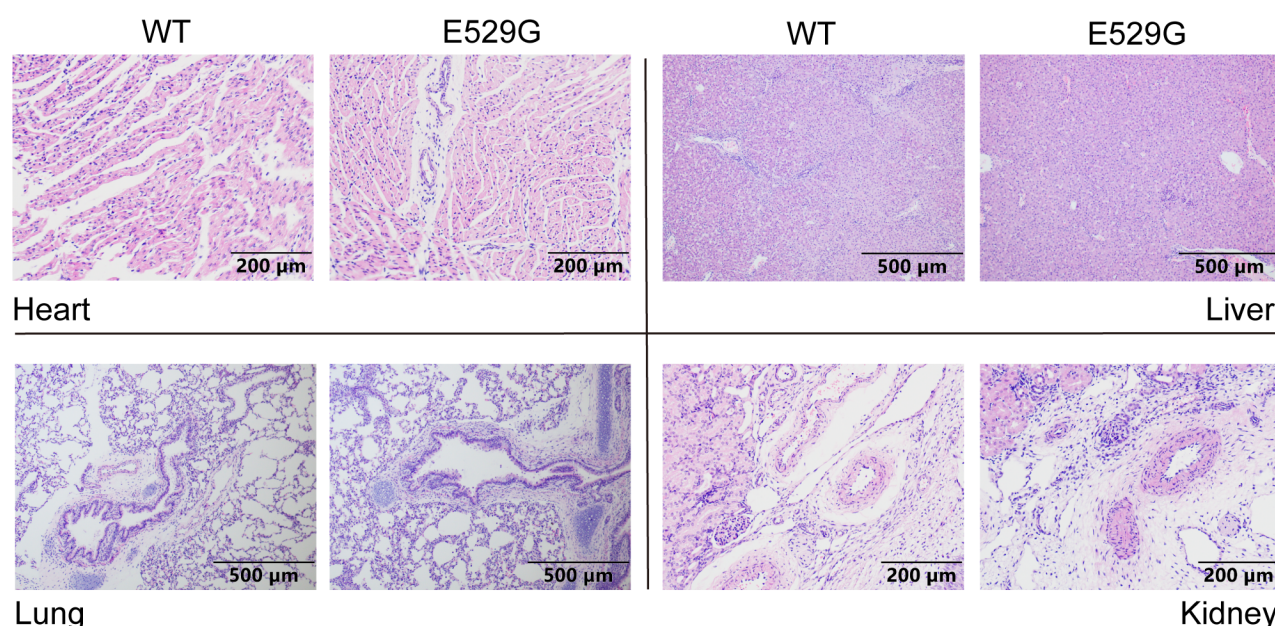


Figure 4 Generation of CD163-E529G mutation pigs

The corrected version of Figure 4B is provided below:
